

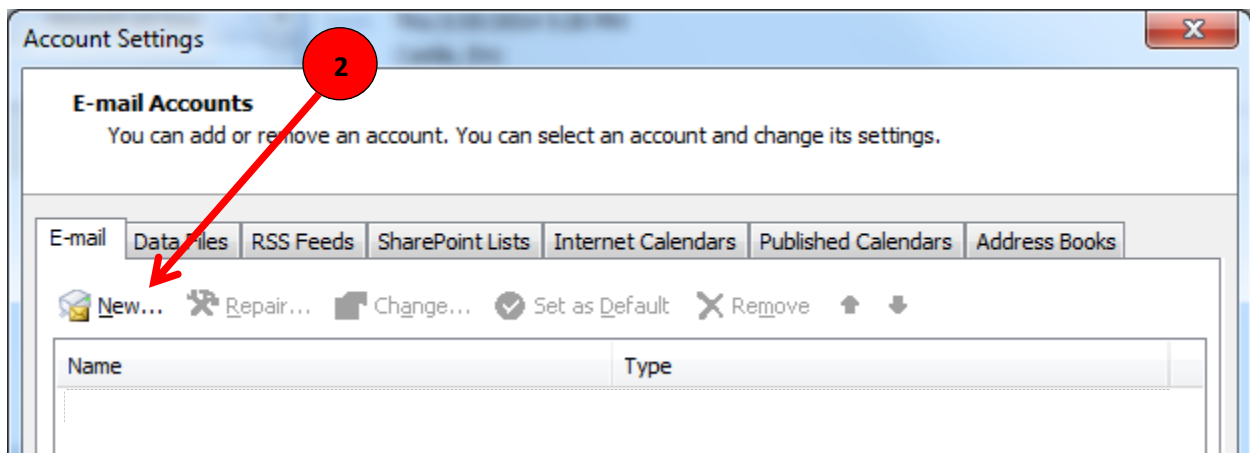


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NetSource E-mail Setup - Microsoft Outlook 2007

If you are setting up Outlook 2007 for the first time, select to add new account & skip to Step 3.

1. Click the **Tools** pull down menu and select **Account Settings**.
2. In the **Account Settings** window, click on the **New** button.



3. Select **Manually configure server settings or additional server types** and click **Next**.
4. Select **Internet E-mail** and click **Next**.
5. Enter your email account information into the fields as follows: (See red letters in graphic below.)
 - A. Your name as you would like it displayed to message recipients.
 - B. Full email address
 - C. Select POP3
 - D. pop.rvusa.com
 - E. smtp.rvusa.com
 - F. Full email address
 - G. Password for the email account
 - H. This option **must** remain unchecked.
6. Click **More Settings**

Add New E-mail Account

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7. In the **Internet E-mail Settings** window, click the **Outgoing Server** tab.
8. Put a check mark in the box next to **My outgoing server (SMTP) requires authentication** and make sure there is a dot selected next to **Use same settings as my incoming mail server**.
9. Click on the **Advanced** tab.

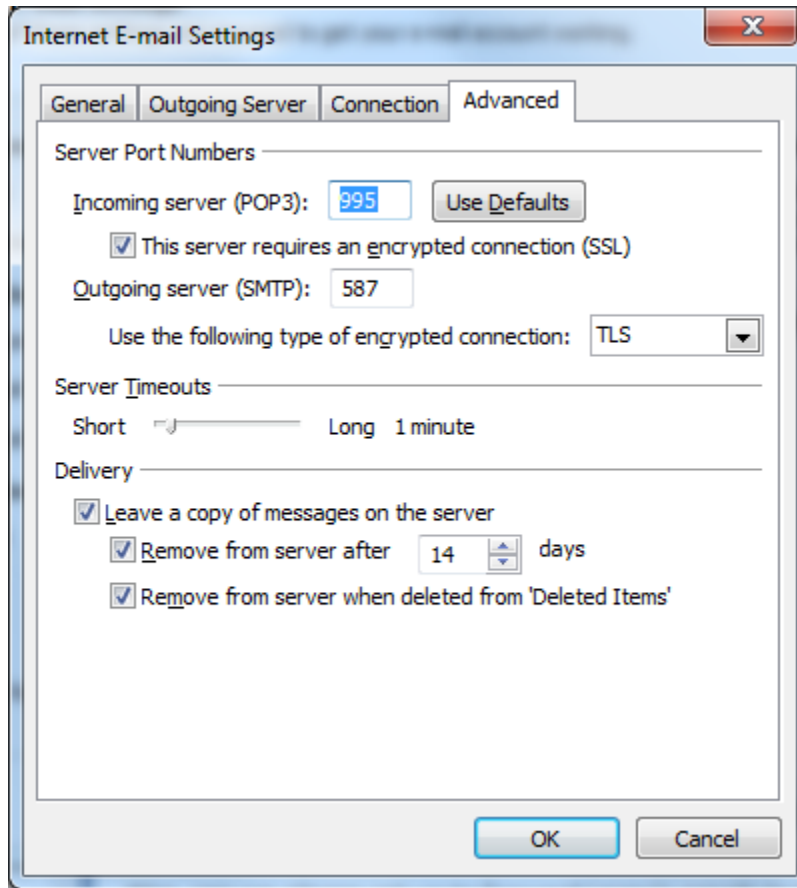
